OVERVIEW:

Ambassadors help United Way of West Florida build long-standing relationships with key organizations and individuals in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties. Ambassadors foster a greater understanding of the needs of our community and United Way's efforts to build a stronger, healthier region. In addition to increasing their knowledge of the community, ambassadors will manage relationships with three to five companies and assist them in planning and implementing successful workplace campaigns. In return, United Way of West Florida provides the ambassadors with a unique program designed to help them develop public speaking and leadership skills while learning from our region's established community leaders.

United Way of West Florida's Development team supports the ambassadors and provides them with the knowledge and resources they need to be successful. Together, we will focus on enhancing connections, building new relationships, and strengthening our community.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend Ambassador Orientation. This mandatory training will help you familiarize yourself with United Way of West Florida, our partner agencies, and our internal programs. You will learn how everyone can engage in activities that benefit the community goals of health, education, and financial stability.
- Attend public speaking and presentation training session. Each ambassador will be required to give a three-to-five-minute presentation before they are assigned their respected accounts.
- Attend monthly Leadership Training Seminars. Ambassadors will enjoy the unique opportunity
 to learn from key community leaders and panels consisting of our partner agencies in a small
 group setting. These trainings are designed to help ambassadors build their professional
 network, develop leadership qualities, public speaking skills, and obtain a deeper understanding
 of the community's needs and resources.
- Serve as an extension of United Way of West Florida by acting as an important liaison to three
 to five companies. You will connect with companies to analyze past performance of their
 campaigns, encourage strategies to improve campaign revenue, and effectively communicate
 the United Way of West Florida message. Ambassadors will help their assigned companies run
 successful workplace campaigns.
- Attend Annual Meeting. Attendance is required for the Annual Meeting as we celebrate our successes from the previous year and look ahead to the upcoming year. The event also includes recognition and awards to key community leaders and organizations. We encourage your supervisors to join us, as well, at no cost.
