PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Ambassador Program at United Way of West Florida is designed to provide professional development through the study of philanthropy. We give Ambassadors the opportunity to cultivate long lasting relationships with key organizations and individuals in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties. Ambassadors play a crucial role in enhancing community awareness and supporting United Way of West Florida's mission. In addition to deepening their understanding of local needs, Ambassadors will manage relationships with three to five companies, guiding them in planning and executing successful workplace campaigns.

As part of this program, United Way of West Florida offers a comprehensive training experience that focuses on public speaking, leadership, and essential networking skills. Ambassadors will learn from established community leaders and engage in a supportive environment aimed at professional growth. The Development team will be there to provide guidance, resources, and support, ensuring the Ambassadors have the tools they need to succeed and grow in any arena.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend Ambassador Orientation- This mandatory training will familiarize you with United Way of West Florida, our partner agencies, and internal programs. You'll explore ways to engage in community activities that promote a healthy community, youth opportunities, financial stability, and community resiliency in Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties.
- **Participate in Training Sessions** It is **mandatory** to attend training sessions on public speaking, storytelling, networking strategies, fundraising techniques, personal branding, emotional intelligence, and event planning. These workshops are vital for developing the skills necessary for effective advocacy. All Ambassadors will be expected to engage with community leaders and panels in a small group setting. This will allow you to build your professional network while enhancing your understanding of community needs and resources.
- Serve as a Liaison- Ambassadors act as an extension of United Way of West Florida by connecting with three to five companies on our behalf. You will review past campaign performances, and work with campaign coordinators to encourage strategies for improvement. You will also provide the assigned workplaces with a clear view of United Way of West Florida's mission, vision, and values. You will conduct presentations as needed to the employees of your assigned workplaces in an effort to expand their knowledge and increase donations and engagement.
- Attend the Events- Ambassadors are required to volunteer for Stuff the Bus, Annual Meeting, and Day of Caring. Participation at these events show your commitment to the community and build stronger bonds with those you are advocating for.



• **Commitment to Training and Events-** Ambassadors **must** have their employer's approval to ensure their availability for all training sessions and events. A commitment form will be provided to facilitate this process.
